

Diesel Technician

 - Any remaining balance after the final deduction is required to be paid back within 2 weeks
 - The monthly payment plan is only applicable to employees of the company
- Upon termination, if a participant still has a balance and does not wish to pay it off in full, the tools then become property of CIT Trucks
- After paying off their current loan, a participant may take out another loan
