Diesel Technician



Join a company with fast-paced, steady, challenging work that will provide you the opportunity to work on medium-duty and heavy-duty trucks. Continuously improve your technical skills and become certified to work on technical and mechanical components.

The **Diesel Service Technician** performs repairs and maintenance work on heavy-duty and medium-duty diesel trucks in accordance with dealer and manufacturer standards.

Responsibilities Include:

- Run diagnostics on medium and heavy-duty vehicles
- Repair various components which may include engines and other systems
- Perform inspection and preventative maintenance services
- Complete online training courses and attend instructor-led classes
- Follow all safety practices and procedures

- Those who partake in the program have 2 years (24 months) to pay it off via payroll deductions

- Participants may choose from any major tool vendor to purchase your equipment (Snap-On, Matco, Cornwell, Mac, Sears)
- Once a participant pays off the balance, the tools/equipment belong to the employee
 - If a participant leaves the company with an outstanding balance, the remainder of the loan may be deducted from the final paycheck
 - Any remaining balance after the final deduction is required to be paid back within 2 weeks
 - The monthly payment plan is only applicable to employees of the company
- Upon termination, if a participant still has a balance and does not wish to pay it off in full, the tools then become property of CIT Trucks
- After paying off their current loan, a participant may take out another loan

Body Shop Technician

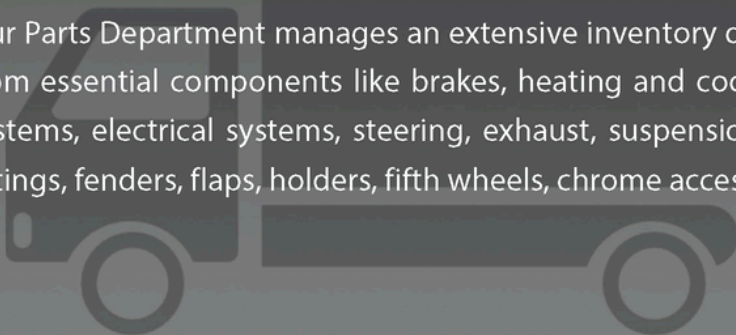

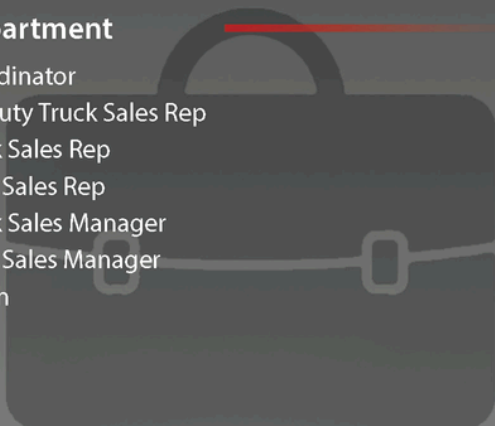

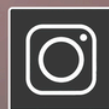
